## A Note from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Pope Francis is not the only person with an upper respiratory tract infection these days, but given his age and what he has been diagnosed with, he is in a precarious moment. The 88 year old Pontiff has been hospitalized since February 14th, first with bronchitis and then with double pneumonia. We should all pray for a return to good health for him. His health has not been good lately. When I was in Rome last month and saw him up close, he did not look well, but he keeps a rather demanding schedule. Let us hope that he can return to his duties as he sees fit.

One very fortunate aspect of the Jubilee Holy Year is that part of each set of prayers for the Plenary Indulgence includes prayers for the Holy Father. I am certain that those extra prayers will be very beneficial for the Pope.

I myself am dealing with an upper respiratory tract infection (as of Presidents Day). Hopefully, I will be done with it by the time you are reading this. Many people are coming down with all sorts of viruses and colds here in the parish and everywhere. (It was the same in Rome last month.) My two year old great-niece, Julia, was hospitalized with RSV and pneumonia last month but thankfully she is well now. (Her parents and her brother got pretty sick, too.)

Bottom line! Lets all keep praying for those who are sick as well as those who have more severe illnesses. Lets also be diligent about washing/sanitizing our hands and staying home if we are sick. It is probably best not to shake hands at the sign of peace and please do not be afraid to wear a mask in church if it makes you fee more comfortable. (Of course, it is not required.)

Hopefully, spring-like weather will arrive soon-maybe around the time Lent arrives on March 5th.
